Dear Colleagues,

*We hope that all of you are well and safe, and that you have built some good memories of the Summer 2021 and some exciting plans for upcoming Fall and Winter.*

We are writing to you with an update on the IAIP Board current activities and future plans. As promised, we will stay connected with you, and these regular updates will be one way of staying in touch.

At this time, our major task is **a smooth and thorough transition of the IAIP Board operations** to a new Board. In pursuit of that, the new Treasurer Michaela Stacher-Linhartmet had a meeting with Horst Gruner in Vienna, and they will soon complete all the necessary paperwork, so Michaela can have a full charge of the IAIP financial operations. Michaela is also completing an updated government-required registration of the IAIP based on new Board appointments.

We have started a process of **website optimization**. You may have already noticed some improvements, such as live hyperlinks to your organizations. Some more work has also been done on a backend of the site that may not be noticeable but is quite important. More improvements are coming soon.

We have completed **a survey of the 28th IAIP Congress participants**, with 100 full sets of responses representing participants from 18 countries. Thank you everyone who took time to share your feedback. We especially appreciate the portion of the feedback that was addressed to the new Board, and all the good wishes and recommendations you have shared. The Board members have done a first review of the results, and we will be sharing these results with the Ukrainian colleagues and with our German colleagues. In brief, the feedback was overwhelmingly positive and very constructive.

We are still in a process of closing the various aspects of the 28th Congress and will be holding a debriefing meeting with our Ukrainian colleagues in November.

Led by Giansecondo Mazzoli, we are having active discussions aimed to **revitalize and to empower IAIP Sections** and to hopefully have **an IAIP conference built by and around the section(s) work**. We will keep you updated.

Soon, we will start to actively work with our German colleagues at DGIP in preparation for the **29th Congress in Cologne in 2024**.

We also plan to have a discussion with our Austrian colleagues at ÖVIP about placement of the **historic physical archives of the IAIP at the AACI in Vienna**.

Through all this busy work, we are also **building the new IAIP Board team**, and this team building is one of our top priorities.
